#### ✚ How credits work:

- “Credits” - “money” you can earn for your ball player to be put into their account to be used for various expenses (i.e. uniforms, state rings, summer league fees, banquet tickets, Spring Break trip, etc.) – credits are held in your name to use at your discretion, if you leave Owasso Baseball for any reason you lose your credits – you will never be issued actual money – credits can be carried over to the next baseball season and used at a later time or

transferred to a younger sibling to be used as they progress through Owasso Baseball

- You can ONLY earn credits if you are a member of the Owasso Baseball Booster Club
- You can earn credits by:
  - Working in the concession stand: \$10 earned for every game worked/\$5 earned for working the grill – to sign up to work in the concession see one of the concession managers, they will take your email address, then you will receive emails with a schedule and you can pick which games you would like to work based on your schedule
  - Working in the press box: \$10 earned for every game worked, to sign up to work in the press box see the press box manager, he will take your email address, then you will receive emails with a schedule and you can pick which games you would like to work based on your schedule
  - Hole sponsors for the golf tournament: \$20 earned for every hole sponsor
  - Ram Cards – for every Ram Card you sell you earn \$15
  - 100 inning fundraiser – any amount raised over \$500 will be put into your credit account (i.e. if you raise \$700, \$500 goes into the booster club and \$200 goes into your account)
  - Work Days – you do NOT earn credits for work days at the field

#### Work Days

- These are Saturday mornings that we need parent volunteers to come to the field and do various jobs (i.e. hang signs, work on batting cages, paint, clean, etc.)
- You do NOT earn credits for work days, however, work days are imperative to make sure we have the awesome facilities/field that we do, volunteers are what makes this program work!

#### Golf Tournament

- Volunteers (LOTS of them) are needed to make the golf tournament a success
- Need Hole Sponsors – Cost of a hole sponsor is \$100 each, for each hole sponsor you obtain it earns you \$20 in credits
- Golf teams are needed for the morning and afternoon golf flights

- Need donations for silent auction, door prizes & team prizes

#### 100 inning game

- Game usually played end of February

- Player turns in 30 names & addresses for letters to be sent out asking for 100 inning game donations
- Any amount raised over \$500 will be put into your credit account (i.e. if you raise \$700, \$500 goes into the booster club and \$200 goes into your account)

#### End of Year Baseball Banquet

- End of May
- All players and their families invited to attend – players free – tickets are \$20/person
- Dinner and dessert catered in
- Beautiful night to honor our players & coaches and end the year by highlighting our seniors
- Takes lots of volunteers to make this a success

#### Commemorative Bricks

- These are bricks that are purchased by anyone to honor current or former players, the memory of a loved one, a great fan or a business.
- They are displayed forever on the “Walk of Fame” at Stigall Field
- They are \$50

#### Owasso Ram Discount Cards

- We are sell discount cards for \$20 each

- Each discount card has various business around the Owasso area that will give you a discount when you present your discount card
- These cards can only be obtained through Owasso Baseball, they are different than any other card being sold by other organizations
- For every card you sell for \$20, you receive \$15 in credits into your account (i.e. if you sell ten cards, which totals \$200, the booster club gets \$50 and you receive \$150 in credits).
